#### Stone of the Month - Carnelian

Carnelian is a type of chalcedony, a milky quartz that comes in a wide range of colors. Carnelian ranges in color from a clear orange red to a dark orange brown and has been known throughout history as Sadoine, Mecca Stone and Pigeon's Blood Agate. The name Carnelian, which is derived from Carne,

Latin for flesh, may be related to its color, which is similar to the color of flesh. It is translucent. Carnelian is composed of Silicon Dioxide, Sio2, and gets its red color from Hematite (Iron Oxide-FeO2) impurities. It has a tetrahedronal crystal structure, and contains a hardness of 6.5-7 on the Moh's Hardness Scale.



Chief localities Carnelian may be found, include Ratnapura, India; Campo de Maia, Brazil; and Warwick, Queensland, Australia.
